The position

Un Ponte Per... is looking for a Medical Advisor for the development of an integrative program of mental health psychosocial support for gender linked problems including training and management of GBV programs carried out in cooperation with the local partner Kurdish Red Crescent in North /East Syria.. The medical advisor should be able to support such training program in the activation process as mental health and gender liked programs.

ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES. The medical advisor will be responsible for:

- To advise and monitor programs aimed at reducing gender inequality and Gender-based Violence (GBV) and at protecting and promoting children's rights including those of women and adolescents,
- To advise and monitor programs directed to mental health and psychosocial support, in primary and secondary care setting, in coordination with maternal, healthy child, and chronic diseases programs
- Coordinating clinical activity with community activities and organization, namely Women organizations and GBV program
- Developing and monitoring protection mainstream programs in coordination with general primary and secondary care services
- Developing and coordinating protocols for protection and psychosocial support in daily and emergency situation, collaborating in the creation of the necessary protection network
- o Training of the clinical staff (doctors, nurses, paramedics, midwifes) in:
 - Social context related to gender inequalities and conflicts
 - Dealing with gender inequalities and protection measures in clinical setting



- Basics of mental health and psychosocial support procedures in daily clinical consultation
- Psychosocial support in health and social related conflicts. Adequate intervention of professional health workers
- Community tools to approach gender inequality
- o Training program of Community Health Workers (CHWs) and Women association members in:
 - Gender inequality conditions in the local social realm. Correct approaches
 - Dealing with psychosocial support in family visiting
 - Basics of mental health for CHWs
 - Community intervention in protection mainstream activities
 - Protection mainstream protocols
- Advising and collaborating with the Project Manager in any demand related to his/her area of expertise
- Elaborating M&E data for reporting purpose Supporting the project managers in the reporting activities
