Project title and summary:

Bridging Communities in the Ninewa Governorate

The project aims to foster coexistence and increase the local capacity for conflict transformation, supporting returnees and vulnerable population groups in their recovery and improving their resilience, by:

- Improving local capacity for civil conflict transformation
- Piloting actions and campaigns for social cohesion
- Supporting strategic coordination among peacebuilding actors

Activities will include:

- A. Awareness campaigns for Coexistence: the winner service provider will be supported by participants and trainees of the training programs to organize cultural and social activities in the following locations; Hamdaniya district and Bashiqa town and Mosul city as small strategic campaigns for coexistence. UPP, as the implementer partner will design a communication strategy among the participants for these initiatives.
- B. Coordination with all organizations and institutions working on peacebuilding and social cohesion in the area,

Period of the campaigns:

From February 1st to April 30th, 2019

Target Group:

The project will target stayers, returnees and vulnerable population groups in the districts of Al-Hamdaniya and in the town of Bashiqa, and Mosul city. Target people of each activity will be selected through to the following criteria:

- Include minority groups in quotas that are coherent with the local composition of population, among Christians, Shabak, Arab, Ezidi and Kakai and Turkman.
- Include members of civil society and local leadership who believes in peaceful coexistence among different ethnical and

religious groups, and are ready to volunteer to make this vision possible.

- Make sure that at least 30% of direct beneficiaries of activities are women, and at least 5% will be persons with disabilities (mostly, survivors from the violence of Daesh and other armed groups).

Location:

Most activities of the campaigns will be run in the towns of Ninawa Governorate; Mosul, Qaraqosh, Karmles, Tel Al-laban, Nimrud, Wardak, Bartella and Bashiqa and surrounded areas.

Sources of financing:

The project is financed by the Government of the Federal Republic of Germany, BMZ. GIZ is providing the grant on behalf of BMZ. Project processing number: 17.1864.2-003.00

Service providers:

Un Ponte per... (UPP) will manage the project on its own, signing service contracts for implementation of some activities with local NGOs having local offices in Ninewa Governorate, with distinctive peacebuilding skills and past experience. At least one of them will be a women's organization working with women peacemakers, who may not necessarily be based in the selected locations. Each NGO can apply for one or more tenders within this project.

Tender description and resources available:

Tender - Peacebuilding services in Ninewa Governorate

The total budget allocated for each campaign will be no more than 5000 USD to be spent according to the following budget breakdown:

Minimum qualifying criteria:

To be considered for review, applicants must meet all of the following qualifying criteria:

- Prior experience in peacebuilding or social cohesion programs for at least 1 years in Ninewa
- Sufficient human resources, and technical expertise to implement proposed activities
- Tender application documents are fully adhered to.

Eligibility of applicants:

Applicants are ineligible to apply if they:

- Have been convicted for an offense concerning professional conduct.
- Have been guilty of grave professional misconduct (proven by any means which the contracting authorities can justify).
- Have not fulfilled obligations related to payment of social security and taxes.
- Are guilty of serious misinterpretation in supplying information.
- Are in situations of conflict of interest (with prior relationship to project or family or business relationship to parties on the Commission analyzing the offers).
- Were declared at serious fault of implementation owing to a breach of their contractual obligations.

APPLICATIONS DOCUMENTS

1. Copy of the organization official and valid registration in KRI and Nineveh/Iraq. If available and description of civil society organization.
2. List of relevant executed projects in 2014-2017 in KRI and Ninewa pertaining to the tender. If available.
3. One-page explaining why your NGO is a suitable candidate to offer these services, according to the qualifying criteria, signed by the legal representative and stamped.
4. One page description of the proposed campaign including; location that is aiming to implement in the mentioned project target areas, timeline, activities, budget, beneficiaries. (2 pages maximum).

APPLICATIONS REVIEW and SELECTION

Applications will be opened on January 21st, 2019 by an internal committee of Un Ponte per... The winning applicants will be selected and notified by email on the same day. Unsuccessful applicants will be notified within 5 days.
